#### Mission and Challenges

Through support of aquatic programs, Beyond Barriers Athletic Foundation makes profound and lifelong improvements in the physical, mental and social well-being of Bay Area youth.

We serve children up to 18 years of age who are members of a "low income" family (less than 300% of the Federal Poverty Level), and who reside in our neighborhoods in need in the San Francisco Bay Area.

2022 marked the start of BBAF's second decade of serving the community, and a return to more normal operations after the impact of the COVID pandemic. Many of our current providers are experiencing labor shortages, which more lifeguard training programs will help address. There's demand for more swim lessons and water safety classes for kids, and we plan to expand our service areas to address this. We also want to increase awareness of the programs we support, so we can serve as many children as possible.

As we look forward to the next ten years, with your support we are optimistic about our ability to continue to bring life-changing opportunities to even more children.



In June 2022, BBAF support made it possible for the East Palo Alto YMCA to train and certify 6 Lifeguards and 1 Lifeguard Instructor. This helps youth from our community find good paying after-school and summer jobs and makes our communities safer. 5 of the 6 lifeguards trained will be working at the EPA YMCA; the 6<sup>th</sup> is working at another local YMCA.


